

BERRY PONY CLUB COMPETITION ENTRY REQUIREMENTS 2014

ALL ENTRIES , on the designated form, are to be sent to Mary Farmer, Events Secretary 4 Tartarian Cres , Bomaderry (02) 44 22 7858 with full payment
No electronic or phone entries will not be accepted until payment received
all cheques payable to Berry Pony Club
all event entries sent to other clubs are paid on BPC cheques only, no personal cheques accepted

CLUB COMPETITIONS (GYMKHANAS)

ALL ENTRIES TO BE WITH EVENTS SECRETARY 5 DAYS PRIOR TO OFFICIAL CLOSING DATE

- Rider must attend 3 **full** rally days in the preceding 12 months
- Must be a financial member of Berry Pony Club at time of nomination and competition
- Must attend **one** rally day on the nominated mount in the preceding 12 months and assessed by an instructors panel safe to compete.
- Can only nominate for a jump or cross country grading level if have grading card endorsed at that level for that mount
- Cannot nominate in beginner or led beginner class if graded for jumping or cross country on the nominated mount.
- Cannot nominate for beginner or led beginner if already competed in an age group class at a previous event on that mount.

ZONE COMPETITIONS

ALL ENTRIES TO BE WITH EVENTS SECRETARY 5 DAYS PRIOR TO OFFICIAL CLOSING DATE

- Rider must attend 3 rally days in the preceding 12 months
- Must be a financial member of Berry Pony Club at time of nomination and competition
- Must attend **one** rally days on the nominated mount in the preceding 12 months assessed by an instructor's panel safe to compete.
- Can only nominate for a jump or cross country grading level if have grading card endorsed at that level for that mount
- Must be a fully independent rider to compete at this level

ZONE CAMP

ALL ENTIRES TO BE WITH EVENTS SECRETARY 5 DAYS PRIOR TO OFFICIAL CLOSING DATE

- Rider must be a financial member of Berry Pony Club at time of Nomination and the event.
- As BPC runs regular jump grading days nomination for jump grading at camp may not be considered, any proposed nomination must be discussed and endorsed with the club senior instructor prior to the entry being submitted.
- Nomination for cross country grading must be approved by the club Senior Instructor prior to entry being submitted (rider must have competed at current grade prior to be considered for an upgrade)
- All entries must go to BPC Event Secretary with full payment

OUTSIDE ZONE 28 EVENTS

ALL ENTIRES TO BE WITH EVENTS SECRETARY 5 DAYS PRIOR TO OFFICIAL CLOSING DATE

- Rider must attend 3 rally days in the preceding 12 months
- Must be a financial member of Berry Pony Club at time of nomination and competition
- Must attend **one** rally days on the nominated mount in the preceding 12 months and assessed by an instructors panel safe to compete.
- All entries must go to BPC event secretary with full payment

STATE COMPETITIONS

ALL ENTIRES TO BE WITH EVENTS SECRETARY 14 DAYS PRIOR TO OFFICIAL CLOSING DATE

- Rider must attend 3 rally days in the preceding 12 months
- Must be a financial member of Berry Pony Club at time of nomination and at the time of competition
- Must attend **one** rally day on the nominated mount in the preceding 12 months and assessed by an instructors panel at a state level to compete
- Competing horse must have current Hendra Vaccination certificate.(this must be supplied with entry)
- All state event have a set required riding level for each age group and nominated riders have to be able to compete competently at this level to nominate

- Must compete at the Zone or designated qualifying event at the required class level , in the championship classes to be eligible to attend the state event
- Can only nominate for a jump or cross country grading level if have grading card endorsed at that level for that mount
- **Horse and Rider combination must also have the additional requirements for each state event (without a reasonable excuse)**
 - 1) Sydney Royal
 - Zone Showriding Championships in the preceding 12 months
 - advanced flatwork/ dressage riding ability
 - attended Sydney Royal selection session
 - 2) State Equitation/ Showjumping
 - Zone Equitation/ Showjumping Championships at the level required by the competitors age group at the state event
 - 3) State Sporting
 - Zone Sporting Championships and have sporting cards endorsed with the required times for each event
 - 4) State Dressage
 - Zone Dressage age group championship Classes
 - 5) State Showriding
 - Zone Showriding
 - 6) State mounted Games - Zone Mounted games
 - 7) State One day event – A zone one day event (Zone 28 or other zone)

If unable to attend the qualifying event permission to compete at a State event may be granted by the Zone Chief Instructor.

STATE CAMP

ALL ENTIRES TO BE WITH EVENTS SECRETARY 14 DAYS PRIOR TO OFFICIAL CLOSING DATE

Application form to be endorsed by Club Senior Instructor prior to being submitted to the Events Secretary with full payment

NSW PCA State Camp is run each year in January at Horsley Park. This is a 5 day camp where specialist instructors provide training session in the following disciplines.

Riders may nominate in more than 1 discipline but will only be able to take part in 1 discipline's activities.

Mount Games

- must be 14 to 16 yrs of age
- D Certificate
- 10 riders are selected at the State Mounted Games Championships
- 5 riders are selected on their competition results in mounted games

and sporting events

Dressage, showjumping and cross country

- must be over 15years of age
- C certificate
- selected on performances including outside pony club performances, must compete at Zone or State event level

Horsemanship

- must be over 15years of age
- C* certificate, working towards B certificate
- overall pony club member, not necessarily competing at a state level in any one discipline
